The staff from Primitive Gatherings (PG) quilt shop and retreat center visited Winneconne Elementary School (WES) last week and presented some incredible gifts resulting from the store's annual holiday event.

Owner Lisa Bongean explained that PG extends a \$10 discount during the holiday shopping season if a customer donates to the annual cause of its selection. This year PG chose WES and was able to donate \$12,705 worth of product and gift cards to the school, including a specialized outdoor swing for the 4K-kindergarten playground, 3 large coding robots and 5 smaller robots for the tutor room, 10 pairs of headphones, 80 - \$50 Amazon gift cards for teacher needs, all items that WES

teachers placed on Donor's Choose wish lists, and other various supplies.

"Small amounts add up," shared Bongean as she addressed the elementary staff. "We wanted to do something that stays right here where we can see it making a difference. We hope you enjoy it!"

Winneconne's Brody Schaffer showcased his football skills to anybody able to watch the Wolves roll to the WIAA Division 4 state semifinals last fall.

Now, he'll get a chance to perform on a national stage.

Schaffer will be one of 32 high school football players from across the country and one international player participating in Nike's The Next Ones event this weekend ahead of Super Bowl LIX in New Orleans. Schaffer will represent the Green Bay Packers at the event after being chosen by the team to make the trip.

"I am incredibly blessed and truly grateful for the opportunity to represent the Green Bay Packers at Nike's The Next Ones event in New Orleans," Schaffer said in a press release from the Packers.
